

CGI Member Jan Hamik Receives NASPO's Highest Honor

The National Association of State Procurement Officials this year honored CGI member Jan Hamik with the Guilio Mazzone Distinguished Service Award, the organization's highest award. NASPO recognized Jan's tireless effort throughout her government career to promote public procurement and for her exemplary service to the public purchasing profession. She continues that work as a member of CGI and the Spend Management Services (SMS) practice.

Established in 1982 as the Distinguished Service Award Program and renamed in 1994 for Guilio Mazzone, it is the highest award NASPO distributes to members. Mazzone was the NASPO member from New Jersey, a former NASPO president and the seventh recipient of the Distinguished Service Award. His dedication to his career, ability to cultivate relationships and making new members feel welcome led to the renaming of the Distinguished Service Award after he lost his battle with cancer.
