



“STEM Who Am I?” Game (ages 11 – 18 years old)

How to play STEM “Who Am I”? In Person

- Print out or write down the jobs below and cut them out so that they are individual words. Then put all the individual pieces of paper into a container.
- Player 1 picks a job out of the container, shows each of the other players and then puts it back in the container without looking at it.
- Player 1 can then ask up to 20 “yes/no” questions to try and guess the job.
- The other players answer the questions that Player 1 asks, with just yes or no answers. If Player 1 has not guessed the answer at 20, they may receive 1 clue from the other players, they must then guess the answer.
- Then repeat the cycle so that everyone has a few turns!

How to play STEM Who Am I – Virtual Instructions

- The instructor shows students all of the STEM jobs they may select.
- Player 1 picks a job from the list
- Other players can then ask up to 20 “yes/no” questions to try and guess the job. If the group hasn’t guessed the answer at 20, they may receive 1 clue from player 1, but then must guess the answer.
- Then repeat the cycle so that everyone has a few turns!
