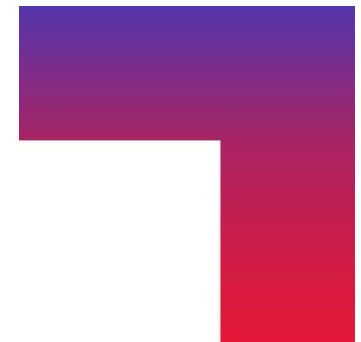


Let's celebrate International Women's Day!
